

Reporter Relationship Help Sheet

Relationship Name	Definition
<i>Action Needed</i>	This relationship should be used for adding Action Needed information regardless of the event. The information in this file includes Action Needed dates, Event Name, Event Date, Action Needed Completed Date, and Action Needed.
<i>Addresses</i>	This relationship provides all fields pertaining to the parent or significant adult including names, phone numbers, and addresses.
<i>DemoEntry</i>	This relationship provides all demographic information for the child. This is also where fields such as Current Exceptionality Status, Current Timeline Status, and Current Service Coordination Status are located.
<i>History</i>	This relationship provides all historical information regarding services that were provided prior to Part B services.
<i>SiteList</i>	This relationship provides all site information such as Site Name, Address, and Phone number.
<i>MostRecentTimeline</i>	This relationship provides all information on Timeline events. This is where fields such as ESE Eligibility Date and Referral for Screening Date, as well as information on screenings and evaluations conducted are located.
<i>MostRecent "Service Coordination Event Name"</i>	This relationship provides all information on Service Coordination events. For instance, to access fields from the Referral In event use the MostRecentReferralln relationship, for the Periodic Follow-Up event use MostRecentPeriodicFollowUp, etc. For all Service Coordination events always select the relationship name which begins with the word MostRecent.

The remaining relationships are used with several different programs in the file. In CHRIS Gold, every attempt will be made to remove these relationships from the user's view and leave only those pertinent to the end user.
